### Main outcome of the project:

As the main result of the project a complex methodology will be developed, which is new and unique on European level. With the application of this methodology transition between studying and work can

be facilitated, those who complete the training can find employment more easily.

The methodological handbook "Work-based learning in CVET" contains the processes of VET and CVET, applied documents

and activities carried out in workbased learning that are impor-

tant for quality assurance, broken down into the set of six building blocks – Design, Improve, React, Communicate, Train and Assess – as recommended by

the EQAVET working group.
