Main target group of the project:

Main activities of the project:

- The foreign partner organizations draw up a manual according to a uniform criteria which contains processes they apply in adult work-based vocational education and training and good practices.
- Pre-testing version of Complex Methodological Handbook is developed taking into account the Finnish, Italian and German methodologies.
- Testing the methodology, running tests in practice.
- The complex methodological handbook is approved by taking into account the opinions

and proposals of experts of the foreign partner organizations in the field of adult vocational education and training and experiences of testing.

- Conducting surveys to measure the impact of the project –among professionals of the practical training place and adult education institution, and training participants – at the start of the project and after the testing of the methodology.
- Exchange of experience of partner organizations in international meetings.
- Organization of multiplier events in all partner countries for promoting the project results.

Main outcome of the project:

As the main result of the project a complex methodology will be developed, which is new and unique on European level. With the application of this methodology transition between studying and work can be made easier, those who complete the training can find employment with more ease.



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“Work-based learning in CVET” methodological handbook contains the processes of adult VET and CVET, applied documents and activities carried out in work-based learning that are important for quality assurance, broken down into the set of six building blocks – Design, Improve, React, Communicate, Train and Assess – as recommended by the EQAVET working group.
