



Supporting European Civil Society Organisations in shaping research agendas!

During the last 4.5 years partners in the PERARES consortium have explored how in cooperation with scientists and researchers requests and problems of citizens and civil society organisations can influence research agendas. Resources and reports of the PERARES project are now available online for download.

PERARES stands for <u>Public Engagement with Research and Research Engagement with Society</u>. This <u>FP7</u> funded project piloted and assessed alternative forms of agenda-setting dialogues and started a web portal for debates on science to articulate research requests of civil society. PERARES also supported 10 new Science Shop like facilities throughout Europe, investigated on the role of higher education institutes and research funders in supporting co-operation with CSOs and organized two international conferences.

The main focus of PERARES (Public Engagement with Research and Research Engaging with Society) was on public debates to encourage, stimulate and generate research questions and requests from civil society to pass them to research institutes and organisations. The project proved new formats for agenda-setting dialogues which included scenario workshops or long term permanent debates between research institutions and civil society organisations. PERARES activities also included a transnational web portal for online debates

The project furthermore contributed to the empowerment of Science Shops' brokering role between research and civil society organisations. Ten new Science Shops were opened in various European countries. The experienced PERARES team offered coaching and support for strategies and action plans to underline the relevance, sustainability and the policy priority of society-research interactions.
